Turkey Hunting Workshop – Session One
January 12, 2010

Class description:

Springtime is a great time to be in the woods and wild turkey hunting is among one of the most popular hunts in Michigan! There is nothing quite like hearing that first gobble as the day breaks! Taught by the National Wild Turkey Federation's Regional Director, Steve Sharp, this class will provide you with all the information you need to get started!
